Outcomes

 Renovated and opened another floor to host group therapy, community gatherings, and staff offices. We hired an additional four new staff members.
 We re-opened Garden House after a full indoor renovation.
• We trained close to 1000 individuals on how to identify human trafficking and how to report it.
 Identified partners locally and globally. Began creating our job readiness program. Hired two survivors.
 We began serving men through case managmeent. Secured funding to help provide housing assistance. Hired a case manager and trauma therapist to oversee the men's program. Identified national partners.
 We had four residents complete our two year long program.
